GROW YOUR OWN FLOWERS

- Transplanting perennial plants is best in early spring or fall.
- Plant tulips and most other flower bulbs in September through October.
- Plant perennial/annual seeds in the spring. Follow the planting instructions on the seed packets. Our last frost date is late March here in USDA Zone 8.
