- Western Washington Fruit Research Foundation orchard has 6 acres of fruit trees and berries suited for our climate with informative signage and espaliers

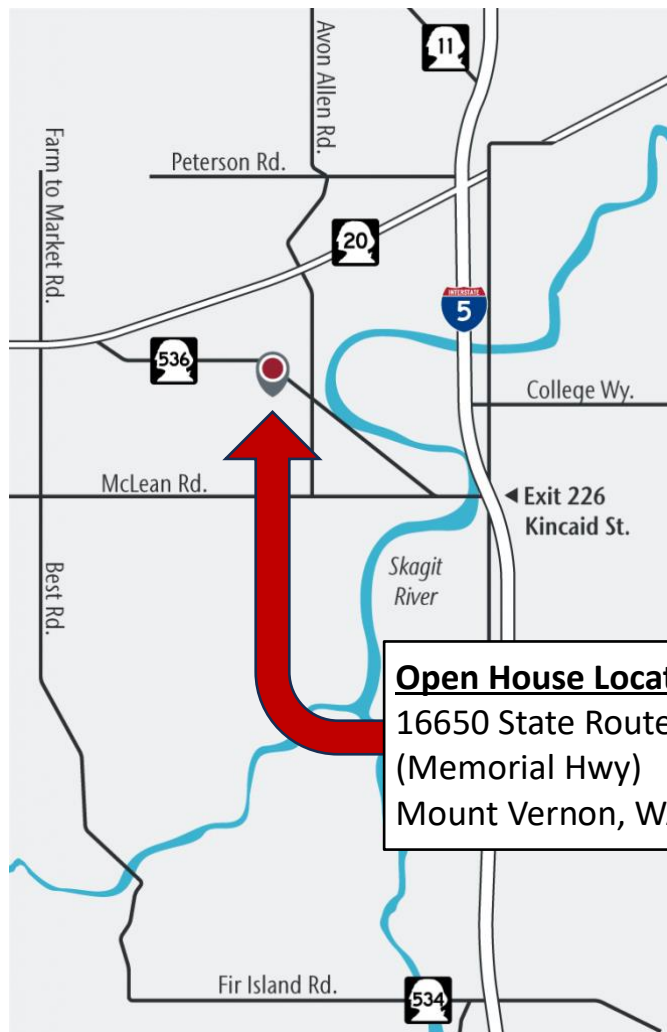
- Salal Native Plant Garden is a half-acre oasis of native plants in a shady natural habitat
